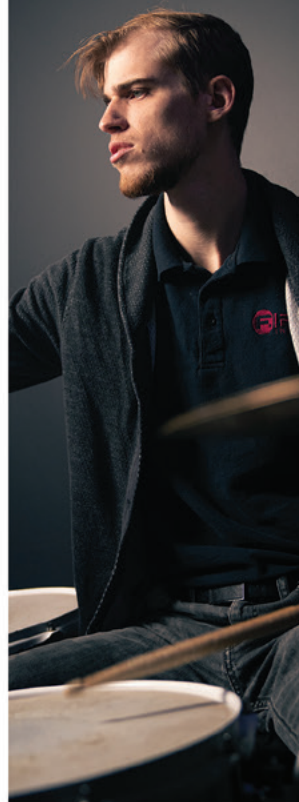

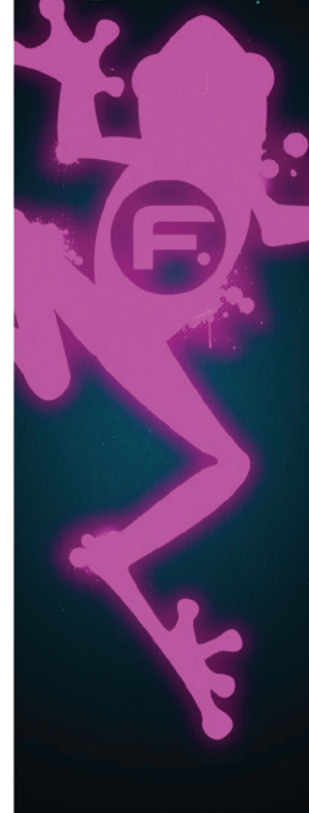

# CREATIVE CAREERS SCHOLARSHIP

## SCHOLARSHIP FOR NEW STUDENTS

F.I.R.S.T. Institute is determined to help any individual that wants to pursue a creative career by offering the Creative Careers scholarship. This is a need or merit-based scholarship for new students who meet the eligibility requirements. Through the Creative Careers scholarship, eligible students may receive up to a certain amount toward the tuition of a campus or IDL F.I.R.S.T. Institute program.

# ELIGIBILITY FOR CREATIVE CAREERS SCHOLARSHIP

## MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for consideration of the Creative Careers Scholarship, you must meet the following requirements:

- Completed an application and have been accepted as a student at F.I.R.S.T. Institute.
- Completed the financial aid process.
- Graduate from a F.I.R.S.T. Institute program in good academic and financial standing.
- Completed a short essay detailing your passion for this industry, what you hope to accomplish, and how this scholarship will help you achieve your goals.

## NOTICE TO ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS

- Scholarship funds cannot be redeemed in cash, and may only be used toward the tuition of a F.I.R.S.T. Institute program.
- The scholarship award will be paid upon graduation only after all requirements have been met.

- Failure to graduate from the program will result in loss of scholarship funds and any remaining balances will be billed to the student.
- Eligible recipients will be notified of award and additional information by their Financial Aid Advisor.



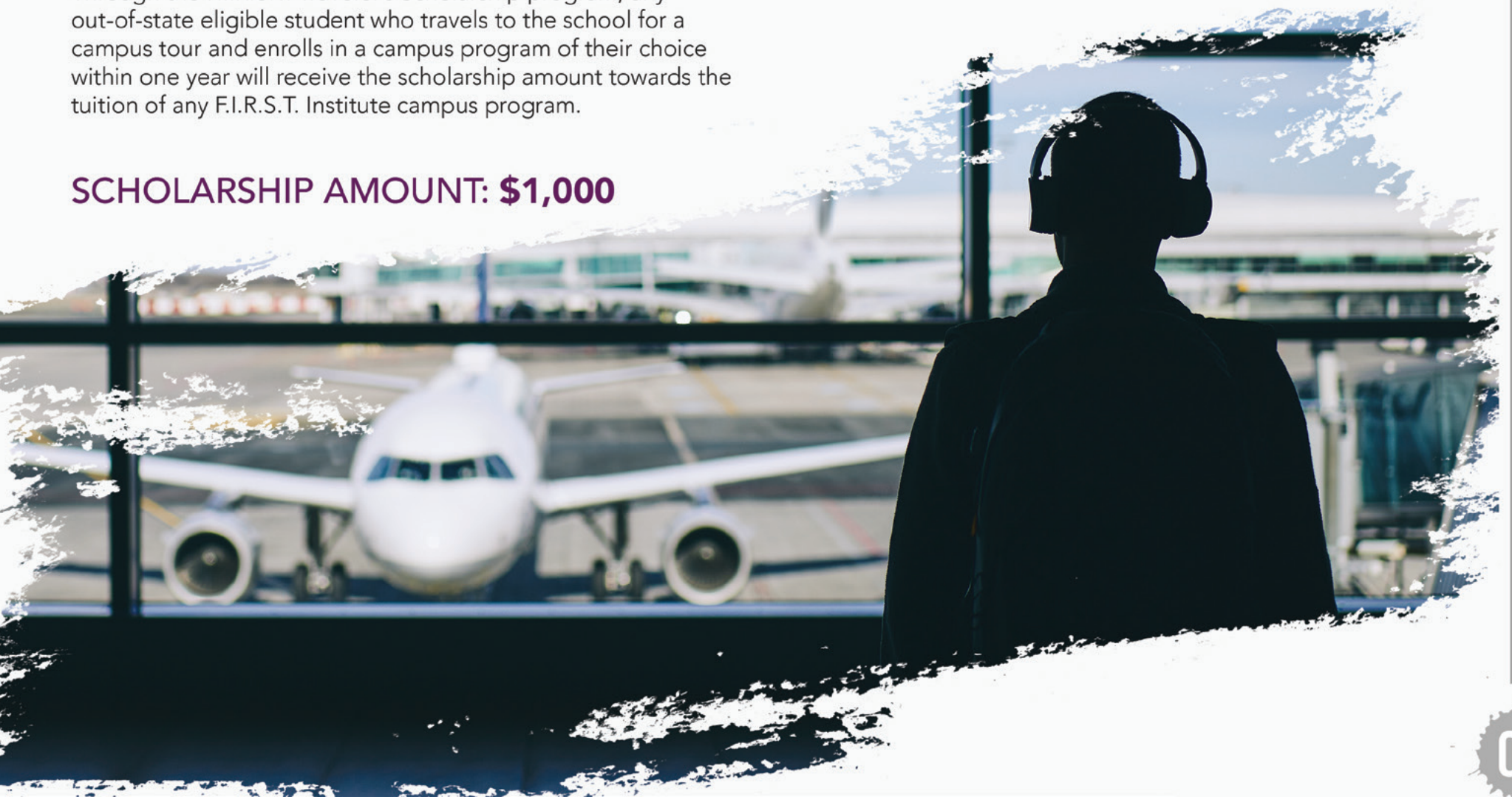


# F.I.R.S.T. TRAVELER'S SCHOLARSHIP

## OFFSETS THE COST OF TRAVEL FOR OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS

F.I.R.S.T. Institute is excited to offer out-of-state students a chance to travel to Orlando, Florida and tour our campus. Through the F.I.R.S.T. Traveler's Scholarship program, any out-of-state eligible student who travels to the school for a campus tour and enrolls in a campus program of their choice within one year will receive the scholarship amount towards the tuition of any F.I.R.S.T. Institute campus program.

**SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT: \$1,000**





# ELIGIBILITY FOR TRAVELER'S SCHOLARSHIP

## MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for consideration of the F.I.R.S.T. Traveler's Scholarship, you must meet the following requirements:

- Have an out-of-state address.
- Attend and complete a tour of the campus prior to enrollment.
- Complete a short essay detailing your tour experience.
- Enroll in a campus program within one year of the tour date.
- Graduate from a F.I.R.S.T. Institute program in good academic and financial standing.

# ELIGIBILITY FOR ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

## MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for consideration of the Alumni Scholarship, you must meet the following requirements:

- Have achieved a minimum overall grade of B (80%) or better in previous coursework at F.I.R.S.T. Institute.
- Have graduated – or will graduate – from a F.I.R.S.T. Institute program in good academic and financial standing.
- Completed a short essay detailing your passion for this industry, what you hope to accomplish, and how this scholarship will help you achieve your goals.
